In 2014, the Hayden Urban Renewal Agency conducted the following activities:

- Adopted the annual budget and managed funds
- Participated in regional and State legislative discussions

- Entered in a parking lot construction and lease agreement with the City of Hayden for property located adjacent to City Hall; said property to be developed as a key parking lot to facilitate downtown development and assist in providing for parking reductions for commercial properties located in the downtown.

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
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• Entered into a contract with an Urban Planning firm, Winter and Company, to develop a strategic marketing and urban design plan for downtown Hayden

• Executed and administered a Disposition and Development Agreement for the remediation of blighted property located at the southeast corner of Hayden Avenue and Government Way to redevelop said site into a public/private parking area

 Purchased blighted property located at the northwest corner of Hayden Avenue and Government Way for the purposes of building demolition, site remediation, and site preparation for resale





In 2014, the District received \$593,809.00 in property taxes and made \$6257.00 in investment earnings. The Agency assets, comprised of interest bearing investments and land, were valued at approximately \$2 million in 2014 compared to approximately \$1.8 million in 2013. 2014 routine expenditures were similar to 2013 expenditures and were primarily related to the annual audit, insurance, utility costs for land owned by the Agency, dues/memberships, and staff/legal support services. Additionally in 2014, the Agency purchased two blighted properties for demolition and site remediation and had costs related to the purchase. The Agency also had contract study costs related to a marketing and urban design plan for the downtown.
